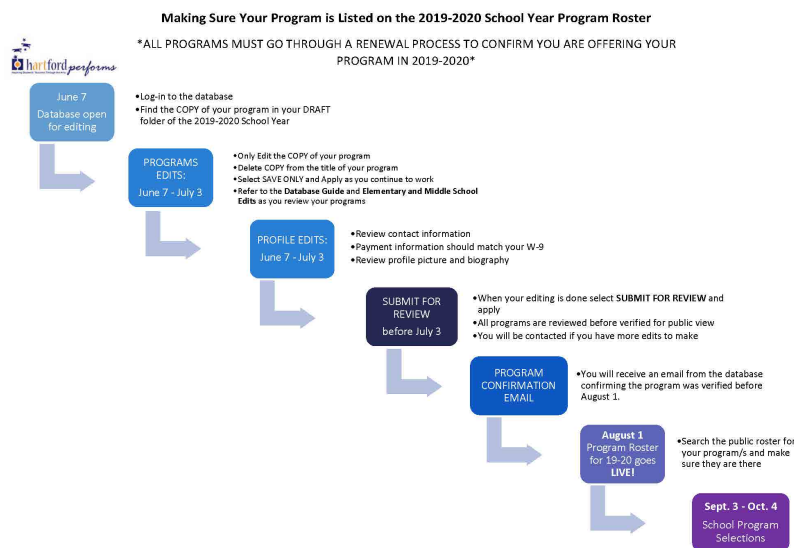
**The 2019-2020 Program Roster will be open for edits beginning on Friday, June 7th through Wednesday, July 3rd.**
